- Holy Week (April 5-10) we plan to share with you electronically reflections and thoughts preparing us for Easter.
- Maundy Thursday, April 9, at 6pm we will share online a brief service remembering the love and sacrifice of Jesus our Lord and his commandment to love one another. His commandment is all the more poignant in this time of community need.
- Children's Wing Renovations: Making the best of this need to remain closed, we are
 working with our contractor to undertake the planned renovations of the Children's
 Wing/TLC Wing classrooms and bathroom during the closure and not during June 2020.
 If this works, we will not disrupt TLC in June and we can be back in full force as soon as
 possible.
- Sanitized: Monday and Tuesday, March 23-24, our TLC teachers and staff worked to bleach, scrub, sanitize, clean, all classrooms, all furniture and implements, chairs, cribs, toys, tables, materials, basically anything that could be sanitized and they washed all washable costumes, toys, and soft surface items. They have worked hard to safeguard our Sunday School and weekday TLC children when they return!
- Sacraments and Funerals: Sacraments: The Office of Worship of PCUSA advises us not to observe Communion or Baptisms until we resume public worship gatherings. Some online churches are allowing viewers to use any bread and beverage and to take them simultaneously online. To maintain the honor and dignity of the shared congregational sacrament, I (Hugh) suggest we refrain from sharing communion until we gather again for worship. Funerals: For any deaths at this time we will hold graveside services with small family gatherings, and once we resume congregational gatherings, we may plan memorial services in sanctuary.

 Decisions: Your Elders, staff, and pastors continue to face difficult decisions and plans, and we remind ourselves that our obligation is to safeguard you and your children, our members, and our neighbors. Know that we care about you, we miss you, and we look forward to welcoming you back soon!
