Remove the sting of death from our lives, that through your Son, Jesus Christ, we may put fear behind us and be strong for those around us. Let us not shy from those who suffer, but instead, may we encounter you, the Risen Christ, in those caring for them and in those working for a cure for this Corona Virus pandemic. Bless and protect all those working for health and wholeness in persons, in places, in communities, and in our world.

Help us also to reach into our lives and correct what is wrong, to reach out to all need of hope and healing, and to reach up to you, O God, and by the power of your Holy Spirit may we know the gift of new life which has arisen before us on this new day, this Easter day, this day of glory and triumph! In the name of our Savior Jesus Christ, who taught us to pray together (Lord's Prayer...) Amen.
