The Session met August 8 and asks that we all wear masks when we are in the building together. Wearing masks will allow us to do the things we normally do in worship and much of what we do in other church activities; and will help us to protect ourselves from this more contagious variant of Covid. We regret this is necessary. We all are tired and frustrated from this pandemic. We hoped we would be in a better place by now, but with COVID-19 variants cases spiking, hospitalizations increasing, and Escambia County positivity rates higher, we will return to our protocols for now so that we can resume regular events as soon as safely possible. The Session will monitor conditions and continue to pursue best solutions to keep everyone safe.

Jesus calls us to love our neighbor as ourselves, to care for "the least of these," and to protect the vulnerable. We still have vulnerable people in our congregation and among our visitors and we still have active cases of COVID among our Trinity members. We ask you to show Christ's love by masking and protecting one another. We are in this together and we will get through this together as soon and as safely as possible.

What are symptoms particular to Delta variant? How do they differ from previous COVID symptoms?

- Fever and cough are present in both types, but
- Headaches, sinus congestion, sore throats and runny noses are more common with the Delta strain.
- Excessive sneezing is also a symptom.
- Loss of taste and smell, a noted symptom of the original virus, happens less frequently.

Why is this variant more contagious?

- There are up to 1,000 times more virus in the nasal and respiratory passages in a person who has the Delta variant compared to the original strain.
- With the nasal load higher, we are breathing -sneezing- coughing singing out much higher volumes of contagious virus particles.
- These variant particles are more contagious/infectious than the prior COVID-19 strain.
- The risk of infection and transmission is higher in unvaccinated people, but vaccinated asymptomatic, people also can unknowingly transmit the virus.
- Vaccinated people with breakthrough COVID-Delta cases are suffering less severe cases
