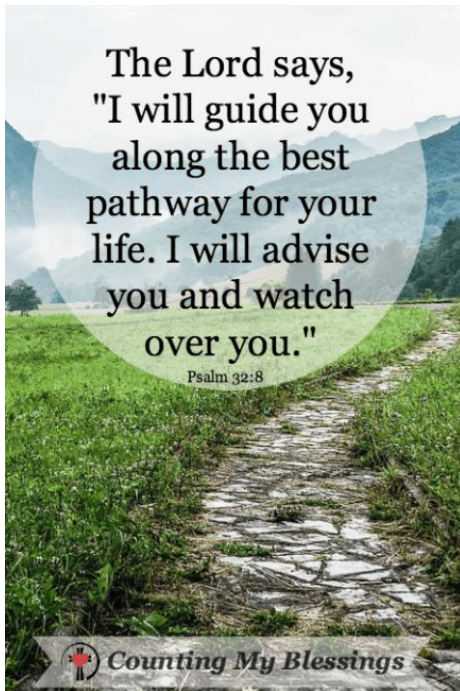

Enough to Live

Recognizing God's Reality changes everything

"Enough to Live" is a complex statement. There are so many contributing factors: where you live (from continent down to neighborhood), when you live (what was normal a century ago might not be adequate today), who you are (or wish to be), what kind of life you choose to lead, and why you live.



You may not have a lot of control over where or when. Who you are and what kind of life you lead are for the most part within your control. And why you live is the foundation of all.

A Danish proverb states: **What you are is God's gift to you, what you do with yourself is your gift to God.**

If all that you have are God's gifts, and if you trust that God will love and care for you, then why you live will be to serve God. Created to be in relationship with God and with others, and taught by Jesus to be a servant. Mark 10:43 **Whoever wants to be great must become a servant.** Jesus repeatedly demonstrated the servant's role, performing menial tasks to show His love and His humility. We each have different gifts and different opportunities, but God will always see that we have enough, all that we need and more "a cup filled up and running over."

God is so magnificent, the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning, the end, and all that is in-between. Our trust in God overcomes our fear of scarcity, and our faith enables us to see past the headlines to the good in the world. God uses us to provide enough for others. It is a giant circle of love, and care, and giving, and receiving. Just to be a part of that, the smallest cog in the wheel, is such an honor that I'm short of breath just saying it.

We don't need to build bigger barns. We need to employ better conduits to those in need because we will always have **Enough to Live.**
